Last ditch blitz

The FPSS-CSQ reaches out to the government

As you have probably learned from the media, negotiations at the provincial level have been intensifying in recent days following the government's last offers on March 31. Which means that we are doing everything in our power to get our sectoral negotiations, which deal with non-monetary issues, moving at the same pace and to secure the mandates we will need to reach an agreement that meets our expectations.

This is why we would like to inform you that the FPSS-CSQ has invited employer representatives to join us in a negotiation blitz for the renewal of the S3-S12-S13 collective agreements.

FPSS-CSQ Vice President of Labour Relations, Pierre Provençal, has contacted the presidents of the CPNCF, responsible for the negotiation of the Francophone collective agreement, and the CPNCA, responsible for the negotiation of the Anglophone collective agreement, who have both confirmed that their constituents and spokespersons would be informed of this call for a blitz. Since negotiating sessions for the S3-S12-S13 have already been scheduled for Tuesday, April 20, we are hoping that this initiative will lead to concrete results before we need to exercise our strike mandates.

We are counting on your support and solidarity with regard to this blitz, which we are hoping will lead to a settlement in the coming weeks.

In closing, you will soon receive another Info-négo to tell you what's happening and provide follow-up information on whether we will be exercising our right to strike.
